June 9, 2015
Meeting Minutes

Present: Chairman Bill Bursaw, Chad Grundemann, Duane Zeichert Andrea Larson and Brad Conklin. Streets Superintendent Scott Turner and Deputy Clerk Michelle Peter and new member Jerry Muehlbauer. Liesle Markevitch was excused.

Chairman Bursaw introduces and welcomed new members Jerry Muehlbauer who joining us tonight and Marne Bruner who will be joining next month who were also in attendance.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Conklin/Larson to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2015 minutes. Questioned and carried 6:0.

Streets and Park Report – Street Superintendent Turner stated the Town had received a \$200 donation for additional Leopold Benches for Doepke Park. Also a \$1000 was received from a Mr. Kickbusch for a memorial bench. A ribbon cutting ceremony was recently held for the new natural trail at Doepke Park. Scott stated he received as well as Town Board members about a complaint for a resident along Lily Ln who is stating that people are letting their dogs run at large and using her yard as a bathroom. Scott said he could install a sign. The solar lighting has been installed at Liberty Park for the flag. Scott noted he has not addressed the trail marker on Teal Avenue yet and is continuing to research swing set companies.

Town Beat Articles – Marne Bruner will be providing an article for the Town Beat on Lily Leaf Beetles which have arrived in the area and feeding on decorative yard lilies. She even brought one in for display. She noted there is no known natural predator of these beetles. Scott stated if other members had articles of interest for the Town Beat to notify him.

Recommendation of Park Kiosk Design – Chad has no additional updates.

Discussion of Additional Swing Set at Doepke Park – It was noted earlier that Scott is researching to companies.

Park Project List –Review and Discussion – Brad stated he had no real updates. He questioned the status of the Lions Shelter at County Highway R and the

possibility of a disk golf course on the Domtar property the pedestrian footbridge.

Financial Statement – Cost were up to date. Summer program will begin June 15th.

Reports form Commission Members – Chairman Bursaw noted he witnessed the seasonal gentleman not wearing safety glasses. Chairman Bursaw and the Committee members thanked Duane Zeichert for his years of service with the Committee and the treats provided. Brad Conklin suggested a clean-up check list for renters at the Doepke Shelter.
