

TOWN OF RIB MOUNTAIN
Public Safety Committee Meeting
February 19, 2018

Acting Committee Chairman, Allen Opall, called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. at the Rib Mountain Municipal Center, 3700 North Mountain Road. Supervisors present Jim Legner and Town Chairman Allen Opall. Chairman Pete Kachel excused.

Also present were Town Administrator, Gaylene Rhoden, Residents John and Penny Happli and Dennis Wald.

The group reviewed and discussed concerns at the intersection of Rib Mountain Drive and Robin Lane. Rib Mountain Drive Phase 2 road reconstruction project was recently completed that included pedestrian facilities. It was noted that somebody visually impaired would have difficulty maneuvering around the corner going southbound via sidewalk on Rib Mountain Drive. The group discussed options to make it easier for a person to determine the turn on the corner and street. Options discussed included making the base smaller on the pedestrian pole, installing fence along the westside of the sidewalk near the IGA and adding a pedestrian apron on the right side. Winter maintenance needed to improve in the area as well.

It was determined that the current intersection does meet the Americans with Disabilities Act requirements.

Resident Happli wanted all future projects to consider the handicap for future road projects.

Additional discussion on the item would occur at the next Public Safety Committee meeting on Tuesday, February 20. The options will be reviewed in the meantime.
