

**TOWN OF RIB MOUNTAIN**

***Budget Hearing & Special Town Meeting  
November 19, 2019***

Chairman Allen Opall called the public hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2020 Town Budget to order at 5:00 p.m. in the Large Meeting Room at the Rib Mountain Municipal Building, 3700 North Mountain Road. Supervisors present were Brad Conklin, Gerry Klein, Jim Legner and Fred Schaefer.

Also present were Administrator Gaylene Rhoden, Finance Director Nicole Dunbar, Clerk, Joanne Ruechel, Street and Park Superintendent Scott Turner and Town Attorney Dean Dietrich

Administrator Gaylene Rhoden went through the Power Point presentation for Fiscal Year 2020 Town Budget which summarized revenues and expenditures and highlighted trends of the towns levy.

The General Fund levy of \$1,824,228 and a Debt levy of \$1,074,962, the total levy of \$2,899,190 reflects a tax rate of \$3.32 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation. The impact of the \$3.32 tax rate on a \$150,000 home is \$498.00.

Chairman opened up the public hearing for public comment. As there were no comments, Chairman Opall closed the hearing at 5:08 p.m.

At 5:08 p.m. Chairman Opall called the special Town Meeting to order. He read the notice of the special Town Meeting.
