

TOWN OF RIB MOUNTAIN
Special Town Board Meeting
March 31, 2020

Chairman Allen Opall called the March 31, 2020, closed session meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. at the Rib Mountain Municipal Center, 227800 Snowbird Avenue Wausau, Wisconsin.

Supervisors present: Fred Schaefer and via telephone conference Supervisors Gerry Klein and Brad Conklin.

Excused: Supervisor Legner

Other attendees: Administrator Rhoden, Director of Community Development Jared Wehner and Street/Park Superintendent Scott Turner via telephone conference.

Motion by Conklin/Schaefer to approve the March 17, 2020 Town Board minutes. Questioned and carried 4:0.

Approval of Agreement for Providing Workforce Staffing During Health Emergency– Administrator Rhoden presented the agreement for the Town Board’s review. The agreement has already been approved by the City of Wausau, Villages of Rothschild and Weston. Also, Dean Dietrich’s law firm has already reviewed the agreement. It was noted that the agreement would include the municipalities in the Wausau metropolitan area. The purpose is to assist other municipalities who may need help with additional personnel during the health crisis. **Motion by Schaefer/Klein to approve the agreement for Providing Workforce Staffing During Health Emergency. Questioned and carried 4:0.**

Approval of Resolution #20-03 Temporary Conditions for Sale of Alcohol Under Alcohol Licenses for Town Businesses – This resolution was the result of a request from a dine-in restaurant in Rib Mountain. With the assistance of the Towns Association and the Attorney, the presented resolution allows restaurants that typically have dine-in services would be allowed to serve alcohol as part of their take-out service. This resolution would only be in effect during the Governor’s ban on dine-in services during the health emergency. **Motion by Schaefer/Klein to approve Resolution #20-03 Temporary Conditions for Sale of Alcohol Under Alcohol Licenses for Town Businesses with the change extending sales to 10:00 pm. Questioned and carried 4:0.**

Approval of Operator License(s) – No comments of concern were given by the Town Attorney. **Motion by Schaefer/Conklin to approve the operator licenses for Corrine Bloch. Questioned and carried 4:0.**

It was noted that the Tuesday, April 7 regular Town Board meeting is cancelled. The next Town Board meeting would be tentatively set for Tuesday, April 21, 2020.

Motion by Schaefer/Conklin to adjourn at 5:10 p.m. Questioned and carried 4:0.
