

## **Town of Rib Mountain**

### ***Park Commission***

**November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2006**

Chairperson Lette Becker called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM. Roll was taken; members present included George Snyder, Duane Zeichert, and Daniel Schneider. Also present were Gaylene Rhoden Town Administrator and Streets/Parks Superintendent Scott Schatschneider.

#### **Minutes:**

The minutes from the 10/10/06 Park Commission meeting were not available.

#### **Doepke Park Pavilion Rental Policies:**

Gaylene Rhoden reviewed the proposed winter rental policy for park pavilion and the revised summer rental policy. George Snyder moved to approve the winter rental policy and the revised summer rental policy, Daniel Schneider seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

#### **Town Impact Fees:**

Gaylene Rhoden reviewed the proposed park impact fees. The impact fee proposal describes the future expenses that will be incurred by the Town to further develop parks in the Township. Adjustments were recommended by the Park Commission, for \$15,000 to be added for landscaping the Doepke Park Recreation Area. The amount for the trail at Doepke Park was increased from \$55,000 to \$100,000. Gaylene Rhoden was excused from the meeting.

#### **Streets and Parks Superintendent Report:**

Scott reported on the current status of Doepke Park and gave a tentative schedule for the upcoming winter recreation season. Scott reported that both rink attendants would like to return. Scott reported that an official hiring would need to be done at the next meeting. Daniel Schneider made a motion to rehire the two rink attendants back. And to have their new rates start January 1<sup>st</sup>. There was discussion if the two rink attendants could or could not be rehired at this current meeting. George Snyder seconded the motion. A vote was taken the motion passed 3-1. Daniel Schneider voted no.

#### **Summer Programs:**

Duane Zeichert stated that he is waiting for a report from Patricia Jahns.

**Winter Programs:**

Daniel Schneider stated that there should be some sort of barrier in front of one of the fitness stations at the north end of the park. This may help prevent sledders from possibly hitting the fitness station on the way down. Daniel also stated that he would produce a daily log sheet for the winter rink attendants. Daniel was excused from the meeting.

**Fund Raising:**

George Snyder gave a report regarding money received from Schuette Movers and money committed for future playground equipment.

Duane Zeichert made a motion to adjourn George Snyder seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
