

TOWN OF RIB MOUNTAIN  
PARK COMMISSION  
Tuesday, June 9, 2009

**Call to order:**

Lette Becker called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Roll was taken. Members present included Shelley Hertz, Bill Bursaw, Duane Zeichert and Bill Miller, George Snyder and Scott Miles were excused. Street and Parks superintendent Scott Schatschneider was also present.

**Approval of Minutes**

Lette asked for approval of the May 12<sup>th</sup> minutes. Bill Bursaw made a motion to approve and Bill Miller seconded. All approved.

**Street and Parks Report:**

Scott Schatschneider reported that the baseball season was going well. The lines had been painted on the parking lot and seem to make a difference in the parking situation. There was a request for a garbage can at Liberty Park. One will be provided for now if it does not fill up with trash from residents. Bill Bursaw asked about people sending guests for weddings to park at Doepke Park. He wondered about a general sign by the parking lot that advises that the park is for park users only. We will see if it becomes a problem first. Bill will inform users of the Rib Mountain amphitheater that they are not to send people to park at Doepke for weddings.

**Doepke Park Recreation Area:**

**A: Memorial garden.**

Shelley reported that the memorial garden looked good. Also the other planter by the sign was growing well. The flowers by the shelter will have to be re-evaluated next season. A dedication will not be scheduled.

**Tennis Lessons/Courts:**

The Rib Mountain School tennis lessons will be held starting on June 15<sup>th</sup>. Patrick Hertz was hired to give the lessons. Shelley did not have information on court crack patching at this time.

**Bike and pedestrian Committee Report-Bill M**

Bill Miller reported that the bike rodeo was held on a very cold and windy day in May and 58 kids showed up. Despite the bad weather it was a success.

**WAYS Soccer Schedule:**

The park commission received an official schedule from the soccer groups that the field would be used on Monday and Wednesday evenings. It will be used by 4<sup>th</sup> graders. We have no commitment from them to do the lines. A contract with them will be discussed later.

**Summer Program-Duane:**

The summer program is fully staffed and ready to go. One of the helpers was from last year and the other (Natasha) had been approved. Duane did not have enrollment numbers because the program had not started yet.

**Future Park Commission Members:**

Lette asked the committee to give some thought to future park commission members. No one had suggestions at this time.

**Financial Report:**

No report.

Lette mentioned that we need to elect new officers in October.

Shelley asked that a budget for new trees at Doepke Park be on the agenda for next time.

**Adjournment:**

Duane Zeichert made a motion to adjourn and Bill Bursaw seconded it. All approved.
