

TOWN OF RIB MOUNTAIN
PARK COMMISSION
Tuesday, Feb 16, 2010

Call to order:

Bill Miller called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll was taken. Members present included Shelley Hertz, Duane Zeichert, Scott Miles, Bill Miller, Sandi Waring and Bill Bursaw. Scott Schatschneider Streets and Parks supervisor was present. Gaylene Rhoden was also present.

Approval of Minutes

Bill asked for approval of the Jan 12th minutes. Bill Bursaw made a motion to approve and Scott Miles seconded. All approved.

Summer Program:

Gaylene reported that the position for the summer program manager would be posted on March 5th. It will also be in the newsletter on March 17th. Applications for the job will be due by April 6th. They will be reviewed as they come in. A recommendation will be made to the Town Board by April 13th. It should be decided by the 20th at the Town Board meeting. This would leave about a seven-week period for preparation for the summer program. The new summer program manager would start immediately. The assistants will be recommended at the March meeting. Mary Timm's niece would like to come back for the summer program. Gaylene mentioned that a recognition lunch would be held for Mary and a \$100 gift certificate would come out of the retirement fund for her 20 years of service. Bill Miller will work on some interview questions for the new manager of the summer program.

Spring Survey:

Duane handed out plans for recreation in other parks from the Wausau area. Bill Miller started a discussion about how much money to put into parks. Sandy suggested that our parks should have different things in each park to appeal to more people. Scott Schatschneider said the survey would give us more information on long-range plans. The need for the short-range improvements was already understood. Scott Schatschneider suggested that we get information from the upcoming census to see what the areas population is and what the larger age groups in the Rib Mountain area are.

Wausau Youth Baseball:

Scott said that the soccer groups will want to use the fields two nights a week. The Wausau Youth Baseball agreement is in place until 2011 and any changes will have to wait until then. The schedule will be adjusted to accommodate soccer.
