

Rib Mountain Park Commission
July 14, 2015
Meeting Minutes

Present: Chairman Bill Bursaw, Chad Grundemann, Jerry Muehlbrauer, Andrea Larson, Liesle Markevitvh and Brad Conklin. Streets Superintendent Scott Turner and Deputy Clerk Michelle Peter were also present. Marne Bruner was absent.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Conklin/Grundemann to approve the minutes of the June 9, 2015 minutes. Questioned and carried 6:0.

Streets and Park Report – Street Superintendent Turner stated he is currently working with Lee Recreation and Miller Company for an additional swing set at Doepke Park. The Town Board is presently reviewing the dog ordinance pertaining to dogs running at large under owner's control. The Town has received a few complaints about dogs using the new trail and running into neighboring yards. The road crew installed 5 or 6 new Leopold styled benches on the Doepke Trail. Scott is also working on the location for the \$1000 memorial bench. John Beatty from the Bike/Ped Committee has been working on a draft RFP for the Trillium Lane Trail. John has also meet with Dave Meurett of the DOT and will provided additional information once it is received. Scott informed the committee he has received word the grant application for Rookery View has received high scoring but has not heard if the Town has been selected. Additional trees have been planted at Doepke Park. Scott noted the lake access marker has not been installed to date. Commission member Conklin suggested having the Teal Ln marker installed by fall. Jerry Muellbrauer stated he had left two messages at Domtar for Kathy pertaining to the disk golf request.

Discussion and Recommendation for Park Kiosk Design – Chad Grundemann stated a ballpark figure between \$400 & \$600 depending on style and quality of kiosk. He noted his online research failed to provide construction design and costs. He asked Scott to contact the recreation manufacturers for cost figures. It was also suggested this project could be completed by an Eagle Scout member or a possible service club project.

Park Project List – Brad suggested the website be updated with project list. A member asked with the redevelopment of the Rib Mountain Travel Center will the Town being working with the new owners in constructing bike/ped facalities.

Financial Statement – Scott noted no major impacts on the budget.

Reports from Commission Members – Chairman Bursaw asked if anyone has heard from Becky Paul regarding the status of the summer playground program.

Adjournment – Motion by Markevitch/Larson to adjourn at 5:48. Questioned and carried 6:0.
