July 11, 2017
Meeting Minutes

Present: Chairman Brad Conklin, Bill Bursaw, Jerry Muehlbauer, Dana Laher, Marne' Bruner and Chad Grundemann. Andrea Larson was excused. Deputy Clerk Michelle Peter and Street/Park Superintendent Scott Turner were also present.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Bursaw/Laher to approve the minutes of the June 13, 2017 meeting. Questioned and carried.

STREET & PARK REPORT – Street/Park Superintendent Turner reported Liberty Park volleyball courts are being used. Scott also noted an increase in park usage. He has no updates on the tennis court's cracking filling progress. The Public Works department has been removing the old wooden posts from the park. Both Liberty and Doepke Parks are framed up for a 6' x 8' concrete slab for the grill installation. Doepke Park is in need of additional rubber chips. Scott noted there is a significant cost for the chips.

- E. Emerald Ash Borer Planning – Spring 2017 – Inventory has taken place at the parks with eight confirmed ash trees. Currently mapping the streets.
- F. Nature Trail Signs – Bill Bursaw stated he had forwarded a note to the individual.
