



# 2018 CAT AND DOG LICENSES



The Town issues licenses for both dogs and cats. The purpose of the license is to allow officials to identify your pet if it were to get lost. The fee is to help offset the amount of levy needed to pay for our contract with the Humane Society of Marathon County as well as Town animal control services. The Town pays approximately \$4,400 to the Humane Society for care of lost pets of Town residents. As pet owners, we all have a responsibility to do everything possible to make sure they are returned home if lost. By licensing them, we are able to ensure this happens. Please license your pet, even if you haven't before.

Pet tags are only issued from the Municipal Center (the bank does not have the tags). You can either mail in a payment or come by the Municipal Center. Please provide a copy of the rabies vaccination, proof of sterilization and a completed form when requesting a license. **A RABIES CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRESENTED IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A LICENSE.**
