The Town issues licenses for both dogs and cats. The purpose of the license is to allow officials to identify your pet if it were to get lost. The fee is to help offset the amount of levy needed to pay for our contract with the Humane Society of Marathon County as well as Town animal control services. Please license your pet, even if you haven't before.

Pet tags are only issued at the Municipal Center. You can either mail in a payment or stop in at the Municipal Center. Please provide a copy of the rabies vaccination, proof of sterilization and a completed form when requesting a license.

A RABIES CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRESENTED IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A LICENSE.
