**Reports:**

Park Commission – Chairman Larson reported the Park Commission met this week. Highlights included an Easter Egg Hunt. The idea was to get families to explore the Town parks. The Dog Park is moving forward with a projected opening date in August. Town's website has been updated with marketing videos of Doepke and Rockery Parks.

Metro – John Beatty note the group is working on another Bike Open Streets project.

Granite Peak Updates – Administrator Rhoden recently met with a Granite Peak representative. The meeting centered on the retention ponds. The representative reported they are also interested in developing a connecting trail system. Street/Park Superintendent Turner stated he is working with Granite Peak on pond maintenance plans. Rhoden has a strong feeling the project will begin moving along. She also noted as they proceed with the project, a public hearing will need to be held and encouraged members to attend.

Trillium Trail – Scott Turner reported the project is still in the environmental phase.

Kocourek Shelter – The Town has met with the builder and conceptual plans are very nice. There will also be a Fix-It Station installed.
