Reports:

Park Commission – Chairman Larson stated the Commissioners discussed the exploration of holding/sponsoring a recreation league or Town event. The Commission is in its infancy of exploration.

Metro – No updates.

Staff Reports – Street/Park Superintendent Turner informed the Committee Rib Mountain Drive Phase II will go out to bid in April. Construction to begin sometime in June. Commercial businesses have been special assessed to defray construction costs. The Town has received RFP's this week for the construction of Trillium Trail project. Proposals will go before Town Board on April 4th for approval. The project will begin construction in 2019. There is ongoing discussion on the best possible route to defray costs. At this point, the best route appears to run under ATC powerlines. Scott stated the crew has installed between 60-70% of the bike signs. Additional signs will need to be purchased. Scott noted there has been dialogue in the form of e-mails pertaining to artwork proposal in the 51/39 tunnel.

Granite Peak Updates – No updates.

Old Business –

State Park Access – A map was provided showing the State Park property layout. Members marked current access points. They discussed areas that could be future entrance points. Should this project proceed forward, they would like to have uniform signage/verbage. Committee members recommended taking photos of current and potential access entrances and incorporating them on the map.

Addition "Share the Road" Signs – Signs have been ordered.

New Business –

Bike Ordinances updates by Intern – It was asked if the Town's intern has been reconciling the Town and State's bike ordinances.
