**REPORTS:**

**Park Commission Report –**

Trillium Trail – Scott Turner reported draft RFPs have been compiled. He hopes to send them out in the next couple of weeks.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

*Recommendations to Town Board Rib Mtn Bike/Ped Map to update on Town's website* – Committee members reviewed the Long Range and Completed mapping that was presented. After some examination members made some minor typo and verbiage corrections. One area of concern and apprehension forced on the inclusion of the pump track on the long range. It was decided to keep it on the mapping with a different category title. Some suggestions were made about using a different mapping format. **Motion by Beatty/Clark to recommend approval of the Long range and Completed mapping subject to the noted changes. Questioned and carried.**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

*Connection proposal to south side of Rib Mountain State Park* – Discussion was held whether or not markings should be installed by some unmarked foot trails. Scott Turner cautioned members to not be too zealous and create a working relationship with park manager Bill Bursaw. Administrator Rhoden also suggested when the state park opens their master plan for public hearings, members could present their desires to the representatives.
